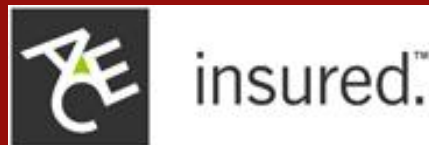

- Ask these questions of your client or IT department
- Which systems on your network do you NOT update/patch on a monthly basis, and why don't you patch them?
- How many systems on the network have blank, default or easily guessed passwords?
- Which applications on the network store customer or credit card data WITHOUT encryption?
