
Key Findings

- Total filings and new enforcement actions down 4 percent from the previous quarter
 - 268 total events: lowest quarterly total since prior to 2009
 - 2013 on pace for lowest annual total since prior to financial crisis
- The number of merger objection cases continued to decline falling 23 percent from the previous quarter
- Capital regulatory actions was the leading type of new securities filing in Q3
 - Capital regulatory actions includes a majority of cases that were formerly classified as securities fraud
- SCA suits filings increased
- Financial services sector remained leading source of new filings
- Total number of settlements down, but average value up
- SCA settlements remained most significant source of large losses with average settlement of \$66.2 million for quarter








Suits by Type







Merger Objection Cases Annualized










Merger Objection Cases by Quarter




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


