


Key Findings

- Total filings and new enforcement actions down 40 percent from the same quarter a year ago (Q1 2012)
 - Nearly equal to the previous quarter (Q4 2012)
- Securities Fraud cases remain the leading type of securities-suit filing
 - Down 4 points as a percentage of the total compared to 2012
 Average
- SCA suits filings ticked higher
 - Both number and percentage of total
- Continued decline in new merger objection suit filings
- Number of SCA settlements down, but average value up




Filings and Enforcement Actions






Suits by Type






Suits by Industry




Key Findings: Compensation Litigation
